



ECHS Cohort Advisory Program

An ECHS cohort is a group of students at the same grade level that have applied to and been accepted into the Early College High School program at CHS. There are four cohorts at CHS: freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. The senior cohort members are often called ambassadors, as they help others understand more about ECHS.

ECHS cohorts meet once a month on Mondays. The cohorts meet with the grade-level cohort advisors in various locations at CHS. At these meetings, advisors have activities and discussions to help cohort members develop a college-going vocabulary, build college-success skills, and promote a college-going culture. Some meetings will have guest speakers sharing their career or college experiences. Other meetings may involve the ambassadors sharing their experiences in ECHS.

As part of the advisory program, ECHS cohort members are eligible to attend a college fieldtrip each year. For the last two years, the junior cohort has attended the national college fair in Indianapolis, where students can explore over 300 colleges and universities from across the nation.

The ECHS advisory program is an extremely important part of the ECHS program. Once accepted, cohort members are required to attend these monthly meetings. Missing three or more advisory meetings can result in removal from the advisory program.
